## Why choose Kimbolton School?


A Kimbolton education combines academic inspiration and rigour, with ample opportunity for young people to understand, explore and fulfil their potential in all areas of life.

Our busy cocurricular timetable and afterschool activities ensure every pupil can discover interests, expand skills and build new friendships.

#### Be curious

Academic clubs and activities nurture cognitive development and ignite curiosity. Pupils can explore interests through groups like Kimbookworms (ages 11 to 13), Astronomy Club, language clubs, The Enlightenment Society, Politics Club, Feminist Society, and the Philosophy for Community Club.

#### Be adventurous

Adventure is encouraged at every opportunity, with outdoor activities such as sailing, canoeing, horse riding, climbing, and windsurfing, alongside participation in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award scheme.

#### Be creative

Creative expression thrives through activities like art, ceramics, creative writing, drama, and technical theatre. Students can also engage in LAMDA, contribute to the Kimboltonian Magazine team, explore technical design with KiMedia Club, or express themselves through dance and filmmaking. Aspiring musicians enjoy numerous performance opportunities with our choirs, ensembles, and music groups.

#### Be inspired

## Wellbeing and pastoral care

When young people feel happy, safe and secure, they can thrive. At Kimbolton School, we pride ourselves on our pro-active approach to equality, safeguarding and pastoral care and by working with parents, we instil values of kindness, good conduct and mutual respect.

#### House system

Our house system builds community and is the focus of a wide variety of sporting, academic and other competitions. First and Second Formers join Ingrams House, which provides a comfortable 'stepping stone' between Prep or primary school and joining a senior house: Balyes, Dawsons, Gibbards or Owens.

#### Wellbeing and pastoral care

We offer a range of initiatives to support the emotional and social development of all pupils, including:

**The Wellbeing Hub** – An online resource offering mental health and wellbeing support for both parents and pupils.

**Wellbeing Room** – A safe space where pupils can seek guidance and support from dedicated staff members.

**Wellbeing Mentors** – Sixth Form mentors provide peer support to younger pupils, while a team of staff volunteers offer advice and encouragement.

**Mental Health workshops** – Practical sessions offering strategies and techniques to address key mental health issues.

**Health Centre** – Our on-site centre provides comprehensive physical and mental health support, with nurses and counsellors available for both pupils and staff.

#### Spiritual life

Our Chaplain is responsible for overseeing and leading most services throughout the School and encourages plenty of pupil participation

in services and assemblies. She is also involved in pastoral care and is available to offer support and guidance to pupils, staff and parents.





## **Beyond Senior School**

Completing Senior School our pupils continue their Kimbolton journey in our popular Sixth Form. We also offer personalised Careers Guidance to help both parents and pupils navigate post-GCSE decisions.

#### Old Kimboltonians' Association

The Kimboltonian spirit reaches far beyond the school, with a vibrant community that extends across the globe. Our alumni value their strong connection to the school, often reflect fondly on their time here and return to reconnect in later years.

The Old Kimboltonians' Association (OKA) hosts three major annual events: the London Dinner, the Summer Reunion and OKA Ball, and the Annual Dinner. These are complemented by smaller regional gatherings, year group meetups, and informal reunions throughout the year.



## **Boarding**

Boarding is available for pupils aged 11 to 18 and we offer flexible, weekly or full time options. Boarding offers the security of living in a friendly rural Cambridgeshire village, within easy reach of London.

Our two boarding houses, Kimbolton House for boys and White House for girls, sit on the historic village High Street, adjacent to the school. Kimbolton boarders join us from around the UK and from overseas and we typically have around 8 different nationalities represented across our boarding community.

Boarding and day pupils are fully integrated, through our House system and shared after-school and weekend activities. Many day pupils also board on a regular or occasional basis, subject to availability.
