### **General Regulations – for all Sixth Form students:**

- A tidy, clean appearance is expected at all times. Students are to ensure that their clothing and shoes are clean, in good order and correctly worn.
- Every article must be clearly marked with the owner's name, including shoes.
- Hair must be neat and of a natural colour. Hair styles should not prevent students from participating effectively and safely in all school activities.
- Trainer-style shoes are not permitted, including black leather trainers
- Jackets must be worn at all times around school. Boys' shirts must be tucked in; girls' shirts, if fitted in style, may be left untucked.
- In winter, plain black, grey or blazer-purple gloves may be worn. Upper Sixth Form students may scarves in a colour of their choice; Lower Sixth Form students may wear white, black, grey or blazer-purple scarves. Hats are not part of school uniform.
- Jewellery:
  - All jewellery must be discreet and of a style suitable for a professional environment.
  - Jewellery cannot be worn during Games.
  - No body piercing is allowed, including facial piercings. Clear retainer studs are not accepted.

The school retains the right to act as the final authority in the interpretation of these regulations.

#### Senior School Uniform – Sixth Form Girls



Overcoat - dark grey, black or navy (no logos)\*

School scarf or plain scarf in school colours (black, purple or grey)\*

Upper Sixth pupils may wear a colour of their choice (no football scarves)

Plain black leather shoes with heel no higher than 7cm (no suede, no stiletto heels)\*

- Earrings are limited to two earrings per ear, and should not be overly ostentatious.
- Lycra bandeau skirts are not permitted.
- No chunky-knit jumpers or sweatshirts.

## Senior School Uniform – Sixth Form Boys







Overcoat - dark grey, black or navy (no logos)\*

School scarf or plain scarf in school colours (black, purple or grey)\*

Upper Sixth pupils may wear a colour of their choice (no football scarves)

- Faces must be clean shaven.
- Belts must be plain black leather with plain buckle.
- The wearing of earrings is not allowed.
- No chunky-knit jumpers or sweatshirts.
