**Castle Opening-Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> October 1-4 pm**

I am delighted to announce that the Castle will be open to the public on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> October. At Kimbolton we are so lucky to have a building of national importance at the heart of our community. You will be able to learn more about the medieval castle, Katharine of Aragon, the Civil War, and the Great Rebuilding by Vanbrugh and even the Castle ghosts.

The tour will include all the State Rooms including the Queen's Room where Katharine of Aragon died as well as the dedicated Heritage Room on the history of the Castle from its motte and bailey origins to it being acquired by the school in 1950.

Please do bring your friends and neighbours along. There is an admission charge, though it is free for young people under 18. To ease the flow and enable you to get the most of your visit, tickets can be booked online on a timed ticket basis. On previous occasion tickets have tended to sell out quickly, so we would strongly advise prior booking.
