



Health Centre Appointments

To ensure all pupils receive the Nursing care they need the Health Centre is moving to an appointment booking system from Monday 15th September for non emergency appointments. An icon will be available via pupils intranet page and QR code posters will be placed around the site so that pupils can book appointments.

Pupils will still be able to attend at break and lunchtime without an appointment and of course will still be seen in an emergency or as part of their individual care plans.

Please see questions & answers which are part of a presentation being shared with pupils by their Tutors this week:

Q. When will I need to book an appointment?

Break and lunchtime	No appointment needed just pop in
During lessons	Please book an appointment (see below)
In an emergency	You can still attend without an appointment
Time outs	Continue as per individual pupil plans
School Counsellors	Appointments with School Counsellors are booked separately and you can still refer yourself by emailing counsellors@kimboltonschool.com

Q. What types of things should I book an appointment for?

Headache Sore throat Nausea Period pain	Blisters Minor bumps/bruises Wound reviews Routine medication	Off games advice Trip paperwork Sexual Health Advice Smoking/vaping support
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Q. What happens if I attend the Health Centre without an appointment?

- You will be triaged by the Nurse to check it is not an emergency
- You will be shown how to book an appointment and asked to return at the next available slot

By using the appointment system effectively pupils should have less of a wait when they attend the Health Centre. It will also enable the Nursing Team to provide a wider range of health promotion activities to the school community.
