# Boarding - your home from home

Boarding at Kimbolton offers the security of living in a friendly rural Cambridgeshire village that is within easy reach of London.

Our two boarding houses, Kimbolton House for boys and White House for girls, sit on the historic village High Street, adjacent to the school. Boarders enjoy a welcoming, familial atmosphere and plenty of opportunities to join activities and weekend trips.

Kimbolton boarders join us from around the UK and from overseas and we typically have around 30 different nationalities represented across our boarding community. Boarding and day pupils are fully integrated, through our House system and shared after-school and weekend activities. Many day pupils also board on a regular or occasional basis, subject to availability.

Kimbolton offers flexible boarding to suit every family. Options include:

- Full or weekly boarding
- **Flexi-boarding** for up to three nights a week
- Occasional stays
- Extended day with supper and supervised prep - providing the benefits of boarding life with the flexibility to return home in the evening.





## Super Curriculum

An important aspect of the Sixth Form experience at Kimbolton is the super curriculum, which prepares pupils for life after school by developing key skills such as research, critical thinking and presentation. This programme includes timetabled lessons and opportunities to undertake an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), engage in bespoke inhouse projects, or participate in Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs).

## Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

In addition to their main subject studies, some Sixth Formers opt to take an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ). This involves a significant piece of independent research outside the main curriculum, spread between January and October of the Lower and Upper Sixth years. This is a demanding but highly regarded qualification where pupils can develop key skills valued by universities and employers. They are also an opportunity to stretch yourself academically far beyond A Level and to pursue any topic area that you have a passion for.

### What is it?

The EPQ allows pupils to embark on largely self- directed independent projects, accompanied with some teacher supervision and direction. Pupils research a topic area, decide on a suitable title, produce their project and then present their work plus conclusions and answer questions in front of an audience. What is produced can vary greatly. Whilst a 5000-word essay on an issue is one method, pupils can also submit an 'artefact' alongside some analysis and explanation of their research. Examples of projects based on this 'artefact' method have included:

- Exploration of the extent of western influence on Japan during the Meiji and Taisho periods
- How game theory can influence military strategic thinking
- Whether stereotypical gender bias reflected in children's literature is comparable with today's social ideology.

The eventual mark is judged just as much on the 'journey' as the outcome – pupils have to log their research, analysis, reflection and evaluation and their logbook is a rich source of evidence to support their overall grade.

## Why is the EPQ such a good thing?

- An opportunity for pupils to develop an area of interest
- It can produce something of a very high standard which goes beyond the constraints of the curriculum
- There is a great deal of freedom in what candidates can actually produce – it doesn't just have to be a written report/long essay (although it can be)
- Is the equivalent of half an A Level and graded to an A\*
- Allows pupils to develop skills of research, independent learning and presentation
- The Presentation Evening is similar to future experiences at university and beyond
- It is something tangible for pupils to demonstrate interest and research in a proposed university course that they are not studying at A Level
- The EPQ is viewed positively by universities and employers.

# Extension Courses

At Kimbolton, Sixth Form is about more than just academic success: it's a time to grow as a person, discover new passions, and prepare for life beyond school. Our enrichment programme on Thursday afternoons is designed to help you do exactly that. Here are some typical courses that we offer:



### **CCF**

The CCF offers pupils the chance to develop leadership, organisation, and teamwork through hands-on responsibility. From leading platoons and planning activities to representing Kimbolton nationally, pupils gain confidence while acting as role models for younger cadets. Sixth Form pupils take on senior leadership roles, ensuring the highest standards are upheld.

### Cooking and Ceramics Rotation

This rotation develops practical life skills and creativity. Cooking sessions build independence, nutrition awareness, and time management, while ceramics offers a calming, hands-on introduction to pottery. Both options allow pupils to unwind, create, and take pride in their achievements.

## Community Service Unit (CSU)

Through placements in nurseries, schools, farms, care homes, and charities, pupils give back to the local and wider community.

These experiences help develop empathy, communication, and leadership skills, while also providing valuable work experience for careers such as education, healthcare and social services.

### Debating

Debating sessions cover everything from Model United Nations to parliamentary-style discussions, public speaking, and school-wide elections. Pupils build confidence, analytical thinking, and communication skills while representing Kimbolton at local, national, and international competitions.

### Film and Technical Theatre Production

Pupils explore the creative world of stage and screen through lighting, sound, set design, and film-making. From stop-motion animations to live theatre productions, this course provides a hands-on insight into technical production and creative collaboration.

### Kimbolton Environment Initiative (KEI)

This initiative combines practical work in gardening, food production, and biodiversity monitoring with trips to farms and conservation sites. Pupils explore environmental challenges such as climate change and conservation, developing both practical skills and a commitment to sustainability.

### STEMM Awards

The STEMM Youth Award recognises commitment to science, technology, engineering, maths, and medicine through activities beyond the classroom. Pupils pursue areas of personal interest, building confidence and enhancing their UCAS and job applications with a nationally recognised award.

### Tycoon (Young Enterprise)

Founded by entrepreneur Peter Jones, this competition allows pupils to set up and run their own businesses. From creating products to managing sales and marketing, participants gain first-hand experience of enterprise, with opportunities to compete nationally and meet industry leaders.

### **Young Reporter**

This national journalism scheme enables pupils to write articles published in online newspapers. Participants gain professional writing experience, strengthen university and job applications, and can compete for national prizes, supported by expert feedback and recommendation letters.


