



How can boarding help you?

Occasional Boarding offers a number of benefits for families and pupils:

- A safe, calm, and supportive environment during late nights

- Reduced pressure on family logistics

Transport at the end of a long day can be difficult to coordinate, especially with a number of pick up times to manage. Boarding for one or more nights can significantly ease this burden.

Remaining on site helps pupils recharge properly, supporting both their academic performance and their general wellbeing.
