School Uniform Regulations

General Regulations – for all Sixth Form students:

- A tidy, clean appearance is expected at all times. Students are to ensure that their clothing and shoes are clean, in good order and correctly worn.
- Every article must be clearly marked with the owner's name, including shoes.
- Hair must be neat and of a natural colour. Hair styles should not prevent students from participating effectively and safely in all school activities.
- Trainer-style shoes are not permitted, including black leather trainers
- Jackets must be worn at all times around school. Boys' shirts must be tucked in; girls' shirts, if fitted in style, may be left untucked.
- In winter, plain black, grey or blazer-purple gloves may be worn. Upper Sixth Form students may scarves in a colour of their choice; Lower Sixth Form students may wear white, black, grey or blazer-purple scarves. Hats are not part of school uniform.
- Jewellery:
 - All jewellery must be discreet and of a style suitable for a professional environment.
 - Jewellery cannot be worn during Games.
 - No body piercing is allowed, including facial piercings. Clear retainer studs are not accepted.

The school retains the right to act as the final authority in the interpretation of these regulations.

Boys – additional regulations

- Faces must be clean shaven.
- Belts must be plain black leather with plain buckle.
- The wearing of earrings is not allowed.
- No chunky-knit jumpers or sweatshirts.



Overcoat – dark grey, black or navy (no logos)*

School scarf or plain scarf in school colours (black, purple or grey)*
Upper Sixth pupils may wear a colour of their choice (no football scarves)

Senior School Uniform – Sixth Form Sports Wear

- Sports clothing and equipment will be required dependent on activities undertaken.
- Pupils chosen to represent the School in sports teams may need to purchase further School Sportswear.
