New for 2026!

Subject to a minimum claim value of £25 there is now no excess on any successful claims so as a parent you will get your full claim reimbursed.

Limits have been increased on certain high value items including cycles, watches and jewellery.

The following benefits apply:

- Up to £2,000 for any one article

- Up to £600 for watches and items of jewellery with a valuation
- Minimum claim value of £25 with NO excess
- School owned devices (laptops/tablets) covered as standard
- No limit on the number of claims that can be made
- With proof of purchase items under one year old will be replaced as new

The cover is designed to protect your child's personal belongings during term time, and while they travel to or from school at the beginning or end of each term, or in connection with an official school trip.



How do I sign up?

The insurance can quickly and easily be purchased through the Howden Parent Portal and your school will have provided you with a login to access that.

This optional insurance runs termly from the start of each term and you can opt-in and opt-out at any time.

Payment is simple as the school will add it to your termly fees invoice. It takes a few seconds to login and you have free access to a 24/7 parent wellbeing service – all the information is on the portal.

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
